Idaho State Championship Downhill & Points Race #1

Here comes a weekend of Downhill racing action at Pomerelle Resort! This race will determine the USA Cycling Idaho State Downhill Class Champions for 2018. Saturday's race is a 1-Run time trial that also counts for full Utah series points. It runs down Pomerelle's "Blaze" course. Blaze features an incredible start through a field of wildflowers and then a twisting, high-speed descent through the forest. This course is very challenging but less technical than Sunday's trail.

Day #1 Start Times

Racing begins at 1:30 p.m. with Cat 2 and 3's on course first. Pros and Cat 1's will start shortly after the completion of the Cat 3's. Please be at the start gate early, if you miss your seeded start time, you may not get a timed run. Start times will be set and posted Saturday at 12:30 p.m. at the base of the chair lift. You should be loading on the lift no later than 40 minutes prior to your official start time. Racers will go at 1-minute intervals.

SUNDAY, JULY 22

Downhill Points Race #2

Great racing action continues as Pomerelle Resort hosts a second downhill race! This race will descend the classic "Pounder" course that made downhill racing so popular at Pomerelle. Cat 3 racers will descend a newer, but less technical course, while more experienced riders will be challenged by faster, but much tougher lines of Pounder. This race will award full series points to top 10 finishers.

Day #2 Start Times

Racing begins at 11:00 a.m. with Cat 2 and 3's on course first. Pros and Cat 1's will start shortly after the completion of the Cat 3's. Please be at the start gate early. If you miss your seeded start time you will not get a timed run. You should be loading on the lift no later than 40 minutes prior to your official start time. The race will be a 1-run format. Racers will go at 1-minute intervals. Individual start times will be posted at 9 a.m. at the base of the chair lift.

KING/QUEEN OF THE MOUNTAIN

New this year: if you're signed up for both races you will be automatically eligible to earn King or Queen of the Mountain honors. Each day's run will be added together and the best combined times will win the K/QOM for their respective classification. See the K/QOM class listing on this flyer.

PRACTICE & LIFT RIDE INFORMATION

Both courses will be ready for inspection from Saturday morning on. Lift fees are NOT included in your entry fee. You must purchase a lift pass for each day you plan on riding the lift. Rates are \$25 per day. A "Race Weekend Special" for both Saturday and Sunday of \$35 will be available to racers. This is a special weekend at Pomerelle since the lift will be running on Friday from 3 to 6 p.m. and a special Fri. Sat., Sun. lift pass will cost just \$40.

PARKING/CAMPING INFORMATION

Plentiful parking is available at the Resort Base and you can camp in the spacious resort parking lot! The Pomerelle Mountain Grill will be open serving great breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday. It's about 20 miles to the nearest lodging so plan on making it a camp-out-weekend! There are Forest Service campsites nearby, but the parking lot at Pomerelle is really a great place for either tents or self-contained RV's. Please make sure you're aware of any open-fire restrictions and plan on packing out all that you pack in. Expect to have a great time camping with your friends, arch rivals, etc. Pomerelle's website has a link to local lodging options.

AWARDS

The Day #1 Idaho State Championship Award Ceremony will take place at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday and the Day #2 Award Ceremony will take place a.s.a.p. after the completion of racing on Sunday afternoon. Both Award Ceremonies will take place on the lawn at the base of the chair lift. Medals will be presented to the top 3 finishers in each Cat/Class. All racers have a chance to win some great prizes via raffles during each ceremony. Pros can expect a cash purse for the Mens & Women's classes.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

To register by mail, send your completed registration form and a check or money order by July 14, 2018 to: Salamander Racing, 61 E. 2050 N., Provo, Utah 84604
Early registration fee for entries **on-line at Go-Ride.com**, or by mail postmarked by Saturday, July 14, 2018 is \$60 per race, or the 2-race discounted fee is \$85. **On-site registration** fee is \$65 per race or the 2-race discount is \$90.

Add \$5.00 for on-site registration (cash or check only).

Each day's downhill limited to the first 140 entrants

Please don't mail your entries in late, you can still sign up at Pomerelle for Day 1 as late as Saturday morning until 10:30 a.m. and for Day 2 until 5:30 p.m. on Saturday. **NO Sunday Reg**, packet pickup only on Sunday morning from 8:30 to 9:00 a.m.

On-site registration at Pomerelle on Friday, July 20 from 3:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Saturday, July 21 from 9 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. **(Race # 1 reg. closes at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday)** and again on Saturday afternoon from 5 to 5:30 p.m.

Unlicensed Cat 2 and 3 riders must purchase a 1-day USAC license for each day they race. 1-day licences are \$10/day and can be purchased at registration at Pomerelle (cash or check only). Pro and Cat 1 racers must have a valid 2018 USAC annual license. **Pro licenses cannot be purchased or upgraded at this event.** Go to www.usacycling.org to process these licenses.

USA Cycling Annual Licenses will be available for purchase at event registration: \$80 for adult Cat 1, \$75 for adult Cat 2 & 3 and \$40 for Juniors 18 and under.
